

Orthognathic Surgery

Orthognathic surgery or corrective jaw surgery is performed by oral and maxillofacial surgeons to correct misalignment of the dental arch and malformations of the facial skeleton. This type of surgery is generally performed in conjunction with orthodontics (braces) and results in the realignment of the dental arches resulting in improvement of chewing, speaking, and significant facial esthetics. Patients with obstructive sleep apnea can also benefit tremendously from these procedures, as well.
